(6) A feed-heater may be used in the case of a non-condensing engine, to recover some of the waste heat in the exhaust steam. (7) Steam-jackets and reheaters are added to the engine under certain circumstances. No portion of a steam plant is perfect, and each is the seat of losses more or less serious. If therefore it is desired to improve the steam plant as a whole, it is first of all necessary to ascertain separately the nature of the losses due to its various portions; and in this connection the diagrams in Plate 5 have been prepared, which it is hoped may...
