Zahm found, hidden away among a mass of old papers, a time-stained little manuscript, carefully stitched together, and bearing the peculiar title: Extempore auf dent Wagen Br. Loskiel. It was written in a feminine hand, in clear, even beautiful German script. The discoverers curiosity being excited, he instituted a careful research, and traced the manuscript back to his greatgrandfather M.Zahm, but could find no positive evidence as to how it came into his ancestor s possession. It is not unlikely, however, that it came into the Zahm family, then members of the Moravian Church, directly through Sister Anna Rosa (or Rosina) Kliest, the original writer and owner of the manuscript, and one of the three persons whose journey it describes.
